### Chamonix film festival unveils the 6th edition poster!

The birthplace of alpinism and world capital of adventure sports is preparing to host the 6th edition of **Chamonix Film Festival**, taking place from 10th-14th June 2026. With a thrilling selection of the latest mountain films, free screenings for local schools, book signings and author events and a series of immersive workshops, the festival has grown into an unmissable event for mountain and adventure culture aficionados.

#### An image reflecting the values of the festival

The event has revealed the poster and visual identity for 2026, with the winning image from their photo competition - 'The Heart' by Julia Roger-Veyer. Taken deep inside a natural ice cave in Chamonix's Mer de Glace, the image features climber Jeff Mercier. A tribute to the fragile beauty of our mountains and the spirit of adventure represented in the themes of the festival.

#### The mountains from every angle

The film selection will feature the latest tales from the world of mountain film, with athletes and filmmakers on hand to share their stories and inspirations. Films in the festival competition will be scrutinised by our international jury, and the sought after Chamonix Film Festival awards created by sculptor and alpinist Andy Parkin, will be awarded as part of the penultimate evening's programme.

Mountain literature is also in the spotlight, with combined film and book events at the cinema, and festival book signings at the Galerie Café des Aiguilles.

#### An event for the whole mountain community

The festival is a place for sharing knowledge and exchanging ideas. In addition to free screenings for local schools and open-air films in Parc Couttet, there are several events for professionals and the public alike.

- Industry day: debates, discussions and presentations for professionals from the world of mountain and adventure film
- Outdoor inclusion conference: organisations working to promote inclusion through mountain activities, in partnership with the Petzl Foundation.
- Workshops at PlanB: a series of workshops on a range of subjects from writing and drawing, to using maps and recycling outdoor gear
